# CLUB RULES AND DRESS CODE

The guiding principle is to maintain an acceptable form of dress and etiquette to avoid embarrassment or offence to members and guests.

## **COURSE ETIQUETTE**

Time expectancy: Lake Course 4 hours / Wales National 5 hours.

Golfers guilty of slow play will be asked to speed up and in some cases may need to pick their ball up and proceed to the next tee in order to reduce the gap on the group ahead. In the most extreme circumstances golfers may be asked to leave the course.

All pitchmarks must please be repaired. During the winter months all buggies must stay on the buggy paths.

Handicap certificates may not be required however it is assumed that all players are competent golfers.

# TEE TIME AND CANCELLATION POLICY

Players making reservations of less than three players may be paired with another player or players. Tee time reservations must be cancelled no later than 24 hours prior to day of play. If a reservation is not cancelled by this time full green fees will apply.

## **COURSE CLOSURE**
